Suicide Prevention Training for Medical Professionals in Alaska

Suicide is a silent epidemic and public health crisis

In the US, suicide is **a more common cause of death** than breast cancer, prostate cancer, or traffic fatalities.

In 2014 the rate of Alaska Native males that died by suicide was nearly **four times** the national average.

All Patients Safe provides the necessary tools to medical providers to understand their role in suicide prevention by teaching them how to:

- Integrate screening and assessment tools into their practice
- Educate patients on keeping homes safe
- Refer patients to additional resources
- Follow up with those at risk for suicide

Continuing Education Statements

Continuing Nursing Education (UWCNE)
