Day 1: When Nothing Works: Strategies for Supporting
'Those Challenging Kids'

Those Challenging Kids

Intended for community members working directly with traumatized youth.

The ISST-D is dedicated to the education and training of professionals and community members in Complex Trauma and Dissociation. For this reason, the ISST-D Alaska Regional Component Group is sponsoring a full-day workshop at no cost for community members who have supportive roles in the lives of children suffering from the effects of complex trauma. The workshop, "When Nothing Works: Strategies for Supporting 'Those Challenging Kids,'" is designed for residential staff and managers, case managers, foster parents, and child welfare staff. This presentation will focus on providing insight into the day to day complex mental health and management needs of traumatized children and adolescents. Early, multiple, and chronic traumas as well as pre-verbal trauma, disrupted attachment and dissociation, and dissociative disorders will be addressed. Niki will provide theoretical knowledge, clinical approaches, and detailed techniques, for those who provide care, effective in managing high-risk traumatized children and youth.

Day 2: Attachment Focused Trauma Treatment: Treating Complex Trauma, Attachment Disruption and Dissociation

This workshop is for therapists. "Attachment Focused Trauma Treatment: Treating Complex Trauma, Attachment Disruption, and Dissociation," is a one-day workshop for clinicians working with traumatized youth and their families. This workshop will provide theoretical knowledge, clinical approaches, and specific techniques which are indispensable in treating these challenging high-risk young clients. It will combine recent knowledge, research, and theories in developmental traumatology providing a treatment approach to determine direction and order with flexibility to adapt to "real clients in the real world", regardless of their trauma and attachment histories, family and living situations, or difficulties engaging in supportive therapeutic relationships.

Niki has lectured on Complex Trauma and Attachment with the ISSTD, the International Society for Traumatic Stress Studies, the European Society for Traumatic Stress Studies, Association for Training on Trauma and Attachment in Children, and the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers. She is an active member and Fellow of the International Society for the Study of Trauma and Dissociation and a winner of the ISSTD 2016 written media award for her book, "Attachment-Focused Trauma Treatment for Children and Adolescents: Phase-Oriented Strategies for Addressing Complex Trauma Disorders," 2015. Routledge. Her second book, "The Attachment-Focused Toolbox: Phase-Oriented Techniques for Treating Complex Trauma in Children and Adolescents," is scheduled for release in September of this year.


